To address the challenges posed by the second wave of Covid-19, CII, CII Foundation and Young Indians (Yi), a CII initiative, are undertaking a host of initiatives to preserve lives and livelihoods. The Relief and Rehabilitation efforts are centred around:



Procurement and Deployment of Medical Equipment such as oxygen cylinders, O2 concentrators and ventilators in hospitals across the country.

RECENT KEY INITIATIVES

Northern Region

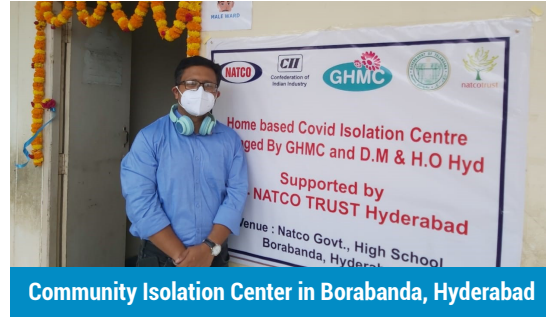
- In Fatehabad, Haryana, Members of the Thakur Agriculture Society, with the support of CII Foundation have sanitized villages to prevent the spread of Covid-19. This initiative is being supported by CLP India, which is supporting many Covid-19 relief initiatives of CII.
- CII Member from Himachal, Cosmo Ferrites Ltd provided support for oxygen plants to ESI Hospital Parwanoo and donated 50 oximeters to the local administration.
- CII Member Regal Kitchen Foods Ltd's Stonex Foundation donated 15 D type oxygen concentrators and 10 flow meter kits to CII Foundation, which were handed over by CII to the District Administration, Solan.
- CII Member Shimla Hills Offerings Pvt Ltd donated Covid-19 medicines to the District Administration, Kangra. This initiative was started by CII Himachal Pradesh State Council.

- A 40-bed community isolation centre has been set up at Natco Government School, Site-3 Borabanda, Hyderabad. This is a joint initiative of NATCO Trust, CII & GHMC. At the Centre, 24-hour Doctor and Nursing care and food will be available and any CII Member company employee in Borabanda can avail of the facilities.

Distribution of oxygen concentrators in Belagavi

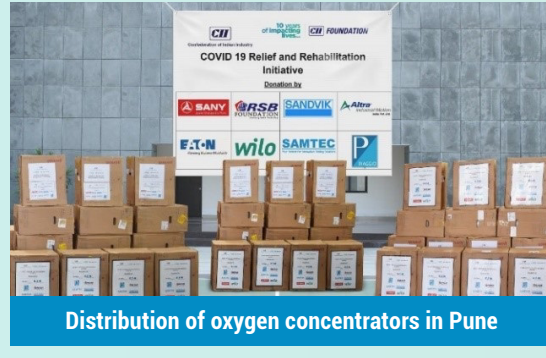
- In Karnataka, CII Belagavi District Council Members facilitated the support to the Belagavi City Corporation by providing 20 oxygen concentrators to the Covid Care Centre. The Members who have contributed towards this are Jaybharat Foundation (Ashok Iron Group), Vega Auto Accessories, Sneham Foundation (Sneham International), Rec. Flow Engineering, Shanti Fomach, Orione Hydraulics, Keshav Cements & Infra, Netalkar Engineers, Valcraft Engineers.



Distribution of oxygen concentrators in Puducherry

Western Region

- In Gujarat, KHS Machinery Provided 40 oxygen concentrators to the Collector of Kheda District. These will be distributed in rural Government hospitals for oxygen support for Covid patients.
- In Goa, CII Goa procured 200 pulse oximeters which were handed over to Goa Medical College Super Speciality Block as per their requirement. The remaining oximeters will be given to other hospitals as required.
- In Pune, CII Pune with the support of CII Foundation and industry members donated 150 oxygen concentrators for Pune district. The donation was given to Shri Ajit Pawar, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister and District Guardian Minister Pune, Government of Maharashtra in the presence of Mr Deepak Garg, Chairman, CII Pune and Managing Director, Sany India. In addition, CII Pune would be supporting ventilators, oxygen gas pipeline, oxygen generation plants and other medical equipment in Pune district in the coming weeks.
- CII Foundation has allocated 45 oxygen concentrators of 10 Ltrs capacity for Goa, which will be delivered soon.

Eastern Region

- In Bihar, HEBE Financial has distributed 50 masks, 50 PPE Kits and 50 gloves among senior citizens.
- In Chhattisgarh, Bhilai Steel Plant has provided support by way of 265 mts of liquid oxygen.
- In West Bengal, Ellenbarrie Industrial Gases Ltd has provided dry rations to a local NGO for relief activity.
- In Chhattisgarh, BALCO has donated 2 lakh Doxycycline tablets and 2,000 PPE Kits to the District Administration for use by frontline workers in the Korba District. BALCO also handed over 400 PPE kits to the district administration.
- In West Bengal, the Rashmi Group has distributed 350 food packets among underprivileged people.

Launch of RTPCR Testing Facility: Yi Siliguri

Yi-Siliguri launched the RTPCR Testing Facility with the lowest charge and shortest reporting turnaround time in the city in association with Thyrocare Technologies Ltd.

Starting from 28 May 2021, upto 100 swabs everyday will be collected on first come first serve basis on a nominal charge of Rs 500 and the reports would be available in around 48 hours as against the current trend of Rs 1,500 and 72-96 hours in the city.

The facility was inaugurated by Shri Rajen Chettri, ACP & Head - COVID Care, Siliguri Metropolitan Police jointly with Mr. Raunak Goyal, National Vice Chair, Yi.



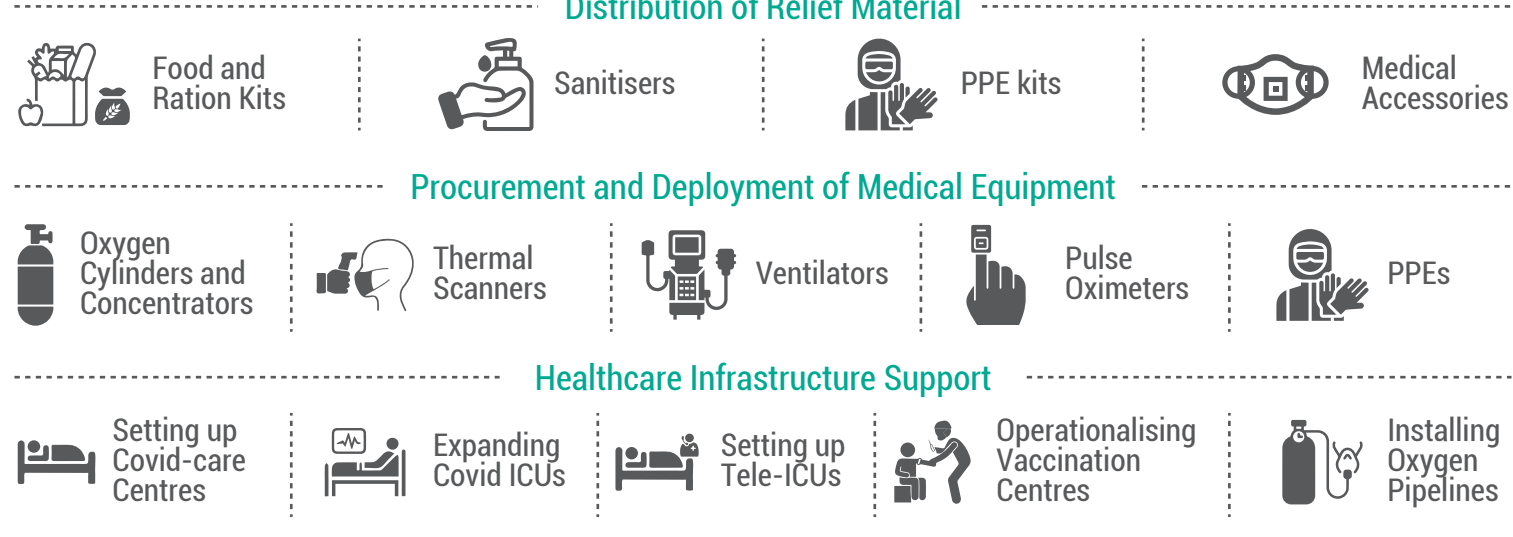
