# Covid-19 Relief and Rehabilitation



To address the challenges posed by the second wave of Covid-19, CII, CII Foundation and Young Indians (Yi), a CII initiative, are undertaking a host of initiatives to preserve lives and livelihoods. The Relief and Rehabilitation efforts are centred around:

**Procurement and Deployment of Medical Equipment** such as oxygen cylinders, O2 concentrators and ventilators in hospitals across the country.

**22,125** oxygen cylinders have been procured and deployed

**Healthcare Infrastructure Support** by setting up Covid-care Centres and Tele-ICUs, expanding Covid-ICUs and installing oxygen pipelines.

**11** Covid-care Centres set up of which one is a 500-bed Centre in Ernakulam, Kerala

**Distribution of Relief Material** such as food and ration kits, hygiene kits such as masks and creating awareness through campaigns, especially amongst households from marginalised communities through the network of CII Foundation Woman Exemplars across India.



## RECENT KEY INITIATIVES

### NORTHERN REGION

#### Haryana

- 100 oxygen flowmeters were handed over to the District Red Cross Society in Jhajjar, Haryana. This has been supported by Jhajjar Power Limited (CLP India) and facilitated by CII Foundation.


#### Rajasthan



Food distribution in Tonk, Rajasthan

- The CII Foundation Woman Exemplar Rama Sharma is reaching out to the most vulnerable families in Tonk district, Rajasthan. Her team will be distributing 300 ration and 500 hygiene kits amongst 500 families of the Banjara Muslim communities, supported by CLP India and facilitated by CII Foundation.

- CII Rajasthan, along with Polymedicure, has donated 13,500 N95 face masks to the State Government. NIMS University has also donated 3000 face masks.

- CII Rajasthan, along with Venkateshwara Wires, Man Structural and Mayur Uniquoters Ltd is providing 500 cooked food packets to RUHS hospital daily. So far, more than 10 thousand food packets have been distributed.

#### Kerala




Hon'ble CM of Kerala inaugurating Covid Centre

A fully-equipped 500-bed Covid Care Centre has been set up in Ernakulam, Kerala. Inaugurated by the Chief Minister of Kerala, Mr Pinarayi Vijayan, the CII -Government of Kerala Covid Second Line Treatment Centre has separate wards for male and female patients and oxygen concentrators, defibrillators, X-ray GE and multipara monitors. This Centre is supported by ten organizations including Infosys Foundation, US Technology International, IBS Software, Muthoot Fincorp, Eastern Condiments Pvt Ltd, Federal Bank Ltd, Synthite Industries Pvt Ltd, Kancor Ingredients Ltd, Suntec Business Solutions Pvt Ltd and ESAF Small Finance Bank Ltd. The project has been successfully completed with the support and guidance of District Administration led by Mr Suhas S, District Collector, Ernakulam, National Health Mission and Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church Medical College. Adlux Convention Centre has extended the facility free of cost.


- Mr K Bhavadasan, Chairman, CII Thrissur Zonal Council handed over ventilators to the Government Medical College, Thrissur as part of the CII Thrissur Zone Covid-19 relief initiative.

#### Telangana

- With the support of Tech Mahindra, CII Telangana donated 25 hospital beds to Director, MNJ Cancer Hospital and 300 N95 masks, supported by TCS.



Hospital beds and masks donated in Telangana




Food distribution in Hyderabad

### WESTERN REGION

#### Goa

- As part of the COVID-19 Relief Initiative, CII Goa office bearers met Dr Pramod Sawant, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Goa and delivered another 20 (of 10 ltrs each) oxygen concentrators to the Covid Care Center at Dr Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Indoor Stadium, Taleigao, which houses Covid Patients. So far, 27 oxygen concentrators have been donated by CII.

#### Gujarat

- CII Foundation Woman Exemplar Mana Mandlekar is bringing aid to 130 families in distress in the Harda District of Madhya Pradesh. She and her team of Karate champions are distributing ration and hygiene kits supported by CII Foundation and CLP India.




Ration and hygiene kits distribution in Madhya Pradesh




Medical kits donated in Madhya Pradesh

Masks donated to Gwalior Police




Ration and hygiene kits distribution in Maharashtra



Donation of oxygen concentrators in Maharashtra

- # TOGETHER WE CAN - Members BM Construction and Grind masters donated 65 oxygen concentrators. Five each are being given to Tribal regions to Lok Biradari (Dr Praksh Aamte ji) at Hemalkasa and Sane Guruji Hospital (Dr Belkhode) at Kinwat while 55 concentrators will be distributed in Marathwada through Lokseva Mandal, which will manage the circulation of concentrators for home treatment of patients. This will free up space in the hospitals for serious patients.

- Mayura Group has donated 50 oxygen cylinders to Covid care centre, Kolhapur.
- 6000 N95 Masks and 3000 sanitizers were given to the District Police Administration, Kolhapur, by Member companies including Shirol Manufacturing Association and SB Resellers.
- CII Pune, with the support of CII Foundation, donated 81 oxygen concentrators at the Zilla Parishad office in Pune. The following companies donated the oxygen concentrators: Piaggio Vehicles Private Ltd, RSB Foundation, Samtec Tools & Accessories Pvt. Ltd, Sany India, Altra Industrial Motion India Pvt Ltd, Eaton India, CompuCom-CSI Systems India Pvt. Ltd, Mahindra CIE Automotive Ltd. Hyundai Construction Equipment (I) Pvt. Ltd would donate 4 units for hospitals in Chakan area and Piaggio would also donate 10 units in Baramati district.
- 1000 PPE kits, 20 oxygen flowmeters and 200 vaporisers have been handed over to Wada Tahsildar Office by Blue star.


#### West Bengal



Ration distribution in Madurai


Yi Madurai handed over rations to the Child Welfare Association In Didugai and Ramanathapuram for the benefit of children who lost their parents due to Covid.
