To address the challenges posed by the second wave of Covid-19, CII, CII Foundation and Young Indians (Yi), a CII initiative, are undertaking a host of initiatives to preserve lives and livelihoods. The Relief and Rehabilitation efforts are centred around:



Procurement and **Deployment of Medical Equipment** such as oxygen cylinders, 02 concentrators and ventilators in hospitals across the country.

23,285 oxygen cylinders have been procured and deployed



Healthcare Infrastructure Support by setting up Covid-care Centres and Tele-ICUs, expanding Covid-ICUs and installing oxygen pipelines.

11 Covid-care Centres set up of which one is a 500-bed Centre in Ernakulam, Kerala



Distribution of Relief Material such as food and ration kits, hygiene kits such as masks and creating awareness through campaigns, especially amongst households from marginalised communities through the network of CII Foundation Woman Exemplars across India.

1,51,985 face masks distributed

RECENT KEY INITIATIVES

NORTHERN REGION

As part of Covid-19 relief initiatives, ambulance support is being provided to Jawahar Hospital in Jaisalmer for a period of two months (June and July 2021). This is supported by CLP India and facilitated CII Foundation.





To help waste management workers who are the most vulnerable during a pandemic, on the occasion of World Environment week, hygiene kits including sanitisers, hand gloves, masks, soaps, and ration kits were distributed among waste collectors in Abul Fazal, Okhla by CII Foundation in the presence of Mr Jagpal Singh, SDMC area in charge and Mr Jitender, area in charge of Dakshin Delhi Swach Initiatives Limited. The distribution of hygiene kits was supported by CLP India. CII Foundation has initiated a project to support sanitation workers, RWAs and neighbourhood community groups towards managing the neighbourhood waste efficiently in the area. This project is supported by PTC Foundation and PFS.

1000 Rapid Antigen Kits have been given to CHC Jamalpur Jhajjar, Haryana. This has been supported by Jhajjar Power Plant (CLP India) and facilitated by CII Foundation.





CII Foundation Woman Exemplar Kanchan and her team of Covid warriors have distributed ration and hygiene kits to 120 families of Jaunpur district, Uttar Pradesh. The ration and food kits were distributed amongst families from Musahar and Dalit communities who were extremely grateful. This has been supported by Kistler and CII Foundation.

SOUTHERN REGION



Members of CII Karnataka have once again partnered with the Karnataka State Government and set up a 56- bed ICU facility at Sir CV Raman Nagar Hospital and 24 ICU beds at the Epidemic Hospital, which were inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri B S Yediyurappa virtually.

The 56 bed ICU facility at the CV Raman General Hospital has been augmented and sponsored by 3M India, Volvo Group India Pvt Ltd and Hitachi ABB Power Grids with technical expertise from Columbia Asia Hospitals and is expected to be operational soon.

The CII Madurai team handed over relief materials which included 50 oxygen concentrators, one lakh 3 ply masks and hand sanitisers to Mr Thangam Thennarasu, Hon'ble Minister for Industries, Government of Tamil Nadu for the benefit of people in Virudhunagar District, Madurai.



- CII Telangana organises close to 450 meals at TIMS Hospital and 150 meals at Government ENT Hospital everyday, starting from the 29th of May, with the support of NACTO Trust.
- 60 oxygen concentrators have been donated by TCS to CII Telangana out of which 30 oxygen concentrators • were donated to support MNG Cancer hospital, and two Government hospitals in Nizamabad & Waraangal,



CII, with the support of Laxmi Ring Travellers has contributed ration kits for 1 month to the Child Protection Officer of Ooty to support 23 children who have lost their parents due to COVID and is also supporting 550 vulnerable children with high nutrition food such as nuts, sprouts, Meal Maker, walnuts, health drink mix etc. The kit was handed over to Mr K Ramachandran, Minister of Environment, Climate Change and Forest Department, Government of Tamil Nadu on 7 June.

WESTERN REGION

Maharashtra

CII Foundation and CII Pune, with the support of Garrett Motion Technologies (India) Pvt. Ltd, donated 5 Ventilators to B. J Government Medical College & Sassoon Hospital, Pune to assist critical COVID-19 patients.





CII Pune, with the support of CII Foundation and Sandvik Asia Pvt. Ltd donated 20 oxygen cylinders (small empty), 15 bed-side screens, 20 wheelchair folding, 3 motorised ICU beds with trolley, 2 ECG machines, 2 ECG trolleys, 2 recovery trolleys, 5 suction machines, 15 saline stands, 2 Laryngoscopes and 2 biomedical waste bins to New Akurdi Hospital, Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation, Pune.

Madhya Pradesh

- A paid vaccination camp was held by CII at Crystal IT Park, Indore for the above 18 age group, in association with Apollo Hospitals, MPIDC and with the support of Infobeans Technologies.
- CII MP Members contributed to donate 5000 Home Isolation Kits (Medical Kits) to Gwalior District Administration.
- CII MP Members contributed to donate 16000 Home Isolation Kits (Medical Kits) to District Administration of Ratlam, Khargone, Guna & Shivpuri Districts in MP.





CII MP Members contributed and donated 3000 Home Isolation Kits (Medical Kits) to Dr. Satendra Singh, Collector & DM, Shahdol District Administration, Madhya Pradesh.

Goa



As part of the COVID-19 relief initiative, CII Goa through CII Foundation delivered another 50 (of 10 ltrs each) oxygen concentrators to the Chief Minister's Office for distribution and use at the COVID Care Centers across the State. As of now, 95(of 10 Ltr capacity) oxygen concentrators have been donated by CII.

EASTERN REGION



- In Kolkata, a Market Sanitization Drive in the Salt Lake area was undertaken by CII. Over 200 packets of hygiene material were handed over to the vendors of the market. Each packet consisted of Savlon multipurpose (liquid disinfectant), Savlon spray, Savlon handwash, Savlon hand sanitiser, liquid disinfectant, spray and handwash.
- CII West Bengal has handed over 4 oxygen concentrators (10 lt) to the Government of West Bengal.



- In Bihar, Skylark Lab & Analytical Solutions has provided 2100 masks to Covid- affected people.
- In Chhattisgarh, Shri Bajrang Power & Ispat Limited have provided 650 jumbo oxygen cylinders to the local administration.
- In Chhattisgarh, Hira Group has provided 650 jumbo oxygen cylinders to the local administration.

YOUNG INDIANS (YI)

Vaccination Drive

As part of the CII-Yi COVID-19 relief initiative, Yi Coimbatore chapter organised a vaccination drive for Yi members and their families. 260 people were vaccinated in the drive.





Yi Trichy organised a vaccination drive at Sanjeevi Nagar. In all, 400 people were vaccinated. The drive was inaugurated by Mr Anbil Mahesh Poyyamozhi, Hon'ble Minister for School Education, Government of Tamil Nadu.A vaccination drive was also organized at NIT, Trichy where 350 people were vaccinated.


