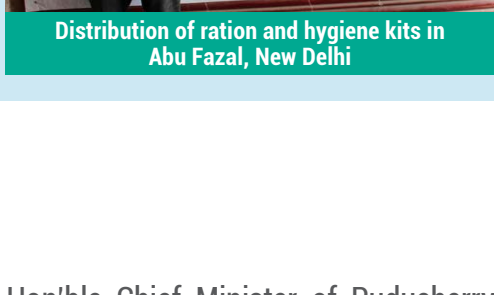

## RECENT KEY INITIATIVES

### NORTHERN REGION

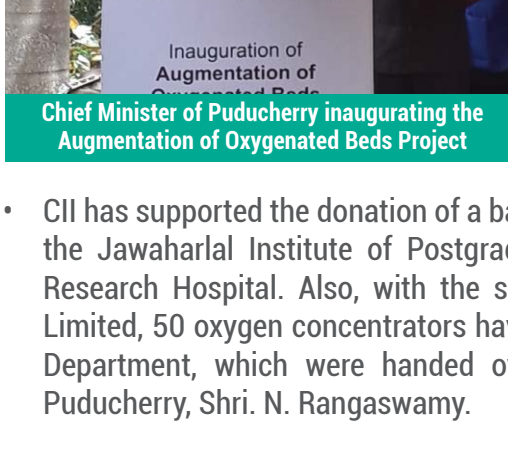
- CII Foundation has distributed ration and hygiene kits to 500 families of Abul Fazal Locality, New Delhi. The ration kits consist of 10 Kgs of rice and flour, 2 kgs mustard oil, 1kg salt, 2 kgs of sugar, arhar and masoor dal, along with spices and tea while the hygiene kits consist of 12 mask, 2 soaps, 1 pair hand gloves along with a sanitizer bottle. The families belong to daily wage workers, waste collectors, auto drivers, and rickshaw pullers. This initiative has been supported by CLP India Pvt. Ltd. and facilitated by CII Foundation.

### SOUTHERN REGION

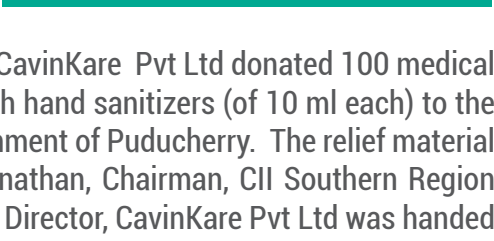
#### Puducherry



Chief Minister of Puducherry inaugurating the Augmentation of Oxygenated Beds Project

- Shri N Rangaswamy, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Puducherry inaugurated the Augmented Oxygenated Beds Project at the Government Hospital for Chest Disease and Indira Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute in Puducherry on 14 June 2021. Around 475 Covid patients can be treated with oxygenated beds in these two Government hospitals. The oxygenated bed facility was contributed by Eaton Power Quality Pvt Ltd, Integra Software Services (P) Ltd; Snam Alloys Pvt Ltd, Hotel Athithi and the oxygen generation plant by Hindustan Unilever Ltd, Puducherry.

- CII has supported the donation of a basic life-support ambulance to the Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education and Research Hospital. Also, with the support of Hindustan Unilever Limited, 50 oxygen concentrators have been donated to the Health Department, which were handed over to the Chief Minister of Puducherry, Shri. N. Rangaswamy.

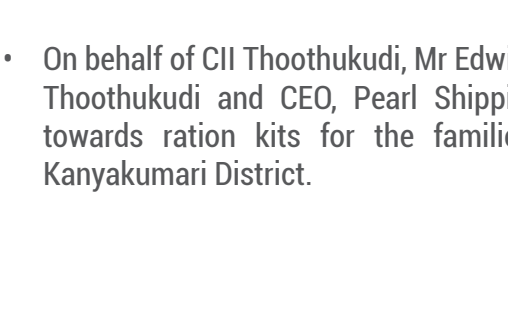
#### Telangana

Food distribution in Telangana

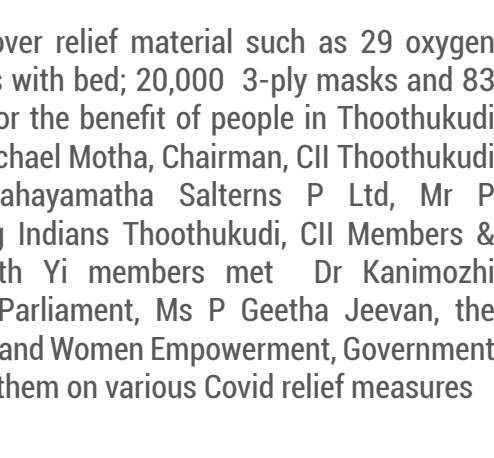
#### Tamil Nadu

Ration distribution for families of fishermen in the Kanyakumari district



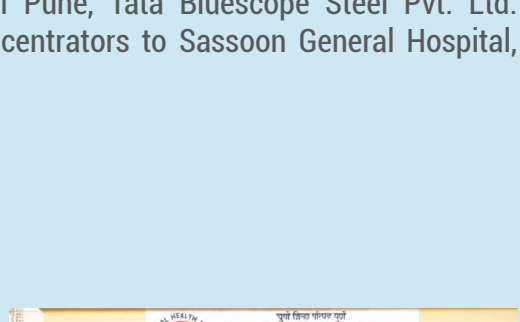
Handing over relief material in Thoothukudi

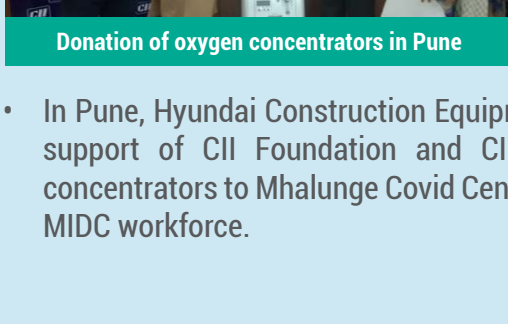
### WESTERN REGION

Inoculation in Pune

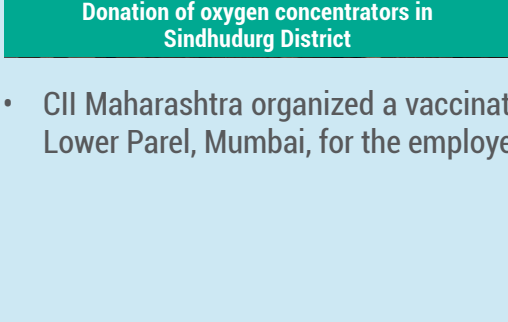


Donation of oxygen concentrators in Pune

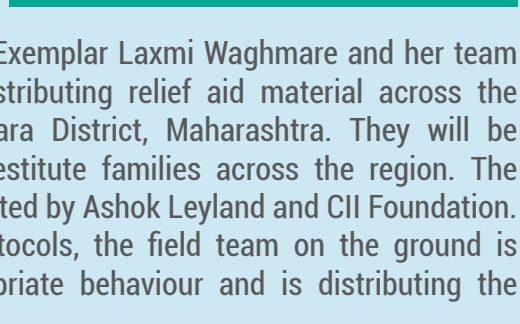
Donation of oxygen concentrators in Pune



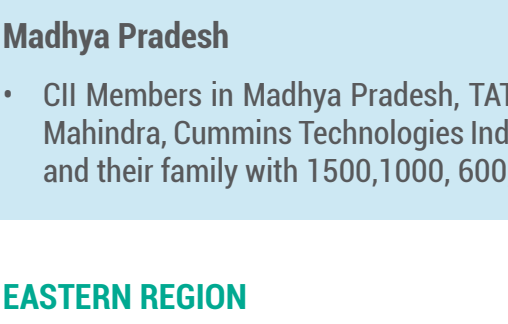
Donation of oxygen concentrators in Sindhudurg District

- CII Foundation Woman Exemplar Relief Waghmare and her team from CORO India is distributing relief aid material across the communities of Bhandara District, Maharashtra. They will be reaching out to 250 destitute families across the region. The initiative is being supported by Ashok Leyland and CII Foundation. Following all Covid protocols, the field team on the ground is promoting Covid-appropriate behaviour and is distributing the ration and hygiene kits.

#### Madhya Pradesh

- CII Members in Madhya Pradesh, Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), Bridgestone India Pvt. Ltd., Mahindra & Mahindra, Cummins Technologies India Ltd. & ACG capsules organized a vaccination camp for their employees and their family with 1500,1000, 600, 850 and 150 vaccine doses, respectively.

### EASTERN REGION

- In Chhattisgarh, the Hira Group has provided 650 jumbo oxygen cylinders to the local administration.
- In Kolkata, over 249 dry ration kits have been handed over to the support staff of Anandalok Hospital, Salt Lake. Each Packet consisted of rice (12 Kg), pulses (5 Kg), turmeric powder (250 Gm), chilli powder (250 Gm), sugar (2 Kg), salt (2 Pkt), cooking oil (3 Lt), Chyawanprash (500 Gm), Horlicks (500 Gm), reusable masks (4 Units), which were donated by Exide Industries Limited.
- In West Bengal, ITC Limited has provided 52 Savlon Multipurpose Sprays, 188 Savlon Sanitizers, 446 Savlon Hand Wash, 432 Savlon Disinfectant and 400 masks under the Covid-19 relief and rehabilitation initiative. This will be used during a market sanitization drive.

### YOUNG INDIANS

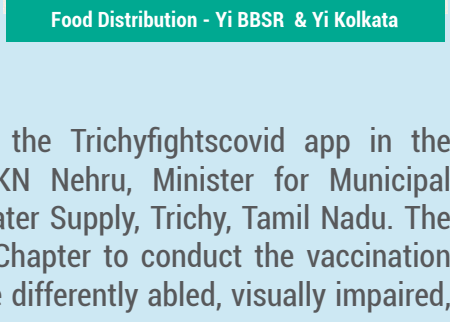

#### Total Beneficiaries Impacted

- 30868 through on ground relief activities (distribution of masks, gloves, sanitisers, raw & packed food delivery, oxygen concentrators, oxygen pads, ambulances, medicines, testing, water bottles, soaps, PPE kits, blood & plasma donation).
- 1123016 through Infographic campaigns (MythBusters, Covid-appropriate Behaviour, Vaccination Awareness, etc).
- 2075 through Vaccination camps.

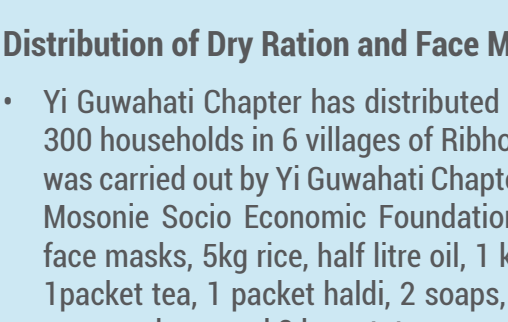
#### Food Distribution

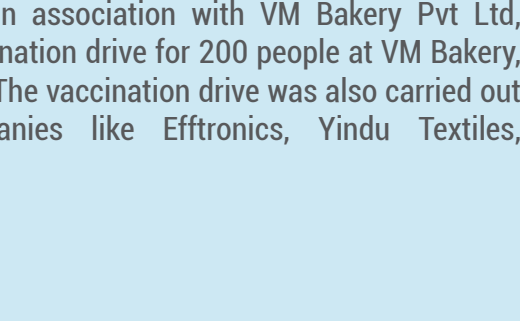


Covid App Launch - Yi Trichy

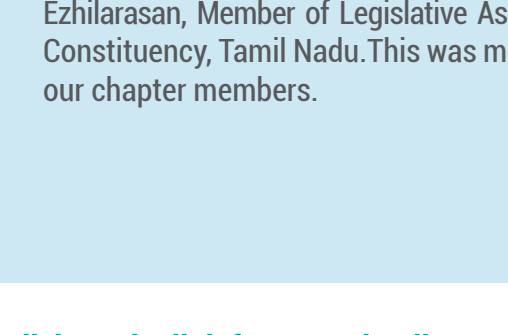
#### Distribution of Dry Ration and Face Masks

- Yi Guwahati Chapter has distributed dry ration and face masks to 300 households in 6 villages of Ribhoi rural areas. The distribution was carried out by Yi Guwahati Chapter Members and volunteers of Mosonie Socio Economic Foundation. Every dry ration kit has 5 face masks, 5kg rice, half litre oil, 1 kg dal, 1kg sugar, 1 pack salt, 1 packet tea, 1 packet haldi, 2 soaps, 500 gm detergent pack, 500 gm soya bean and 2 kg potatoes.
